

VALLEY PARTNERSHIP

At 1.30pm on Monday, July 6, Dulais Valley Partnership will be holding a heritage trail exhibition: schools project at Seven Sisters Community Centre. Over the past year, Katie Millien, community heritage officer, has been working with pupils from the four primary schools in the Dulais Valley to create 3D heritage trails based on what they have learnt of the history of their area. The children have used global positioning systems (GPS) to way-mark sites of interest on computerised maps, visited sites, taken digital photos, made MP3 sound recordings and finally put these elements together using mapping software to produce 3D interactive heritage trails.

This project ties in with existing HLF-funded initiative to produce a heritage trail website and booklet principally being conducted with older members of the Dulais Valley communities, made possible thanks to the Heritage Lottery Fund and Communities First funding.
